Discussion Guide

- **Most of us are guilty of “praying it safe.” Prayer can easily become ritual, routine, and really apathetic. Do you think you exhibit a dangerous prayer life right now, or are your prayers soft, easy, subtle and maybe even petty?**
- **Asking God to search us is a bold request. Too often we pretend like we don’t have problems. Could you take a big step ask God to point out sin and correct it? What are some of those issues that you struggle to be honest about?**
- **Asking God to point out the anxiety in our hearts brings our fears into focus. “Anxiety exposes our fears, and our fears typically expose where we trust God the least.” What makes you anxious?**
- **We encourage you to be open and honest about a time when you have felt most broken in your life. What was your relationship with Jesus like in the midst of those storms? Did your brokenness lead you to lean on the cross?**
- **Do you have the courage you ask God to send you wherever He wants? For some, this would mean a total uprooting and move across the world to serve Jesus somewhere else. For most people though, honestly, it would probably mean Jesus sending us through our familiar paths with a divine, extraordinary mission. For some, this sounds even more terrifying than being called to minister in a hostile third-world country. What and where could God be calling you that you’ve been resisting and refusing to say, “Send me?”**
